Change...it's a pervasive theme that seems to dominate talk on any topic...and Rotary is no different.

On **June 16 Ally Brundige** will speak on her work with youth and community empowerment.

A New Jersey native now living in Wichita, Ally is working as a youth organizer for Hope Street Youth Development.

Prior to that, she spent a year as a Rotary International Ambassadorial Scholar in Durban, South Africa, where she worked with a youth development and gender empowerment organization. She also was involved with Abahlali baseMjondolo, a movement of shackdwellers mobilizing for land and housing.

While there, she also completed a research degree in political science, focusing on youth civic engagement in Durban.

Earlier she served as a policy fellow for a children's advocacy organization, a field worker for a cross-country voter registration drive,

and a youth development director for a community-based youth and children's nonprofit in New Haven, Conn.

Nancy Jackson, Executive Director of The Land Institute's Climate and Energy Project (CEP), will speak on **June 30**.

Nancy will speak on the CEP's mission to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by supporting the development and deployment of energy efficiency and renewable energy. The CEP also facilitates informed, balanced

conversations about our energy future.

Nancy holds an MA in environmental history from the University of Kansas. She has had extensive experience in corporate finance, equities research, scholarly publishing, and development.

The Land Institute, a nonpartisan, nonprofit organization founded 30 years ago in Salina, is developing perennial cropping systems as a new, sustainable option for farmers.
