Santa Fe Trail and the Interact Club

Even though May has five Mondays, we will only be meeting twice, as May 30 is Memorial Day.

On **May 2, Janel Cook**, director of the Coronado-Quivira Museum in Lyons, will be our guest speaker.

She will talk about the Santa Fe Trail.

Cook was born and raised in Lyons. She received her bachelor's degree in history from Bethel College and her master's in Historical Administration and Museum Studies from the University of Kansas.

She ran the Hodgden House Museum complex and Fort Harker Museum in Ellsworth County for several years before becoming director of the Coronado-Quivira Museum.

Cook is currently coordinator of

the National Santa Fe Trail Association Symposium scheduled for McPherson this September.

The Coronado-Quivira Museum, owned by the Rice County Historical Society, is one of the best small museums in Kansas. Separate displays focus on early inhabitants, Spanish explorers, the Santa Fe Trail and the coming of homesteaders and permanent settlers.

On **May 16, Rochelle Reinert**, (member Russ Reinert's daughter) will talk about the Interact Club. (This is our affiliate club at Hutchinson High School.)

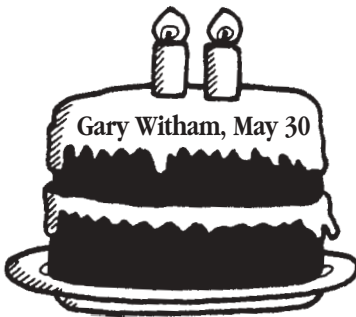
