On **May 3rd** our speaker is Ed O'Malley, Kansas Leadership Center. Ed will be speaking on the Leadership Center and their focus.



As the first ever President & CEO of the Kansas Leadership Center, Ed O'Malley has a deep passion and commitment to Kansas.

Ed oversees all operations of the Kansas Leadership Center, which is funded with a \$30 million grant from the Kansas Health Foundation. The Center is charged with cultivating civic leadership all across Kansas to ultimately improve the health of all Kansans.

Ed served in the Kansas House of Representatives from 2003 to 2007. Legislative accomplishments include authoring key legislation on school finance, identity theft and asset development for Kansans.

Ed earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in history from KSU. He is a graduate and former board member of Leadership Kansas as well as a graduate and past board member of Leadership Northeast Johnson County.

Ed is married to Joanna Leigh O'Malley, and is the proud parent of Kate, Jack, and Elizabeth O'Malley.

On **May 17th** our speaker is Orville Miller from People Behind the Product / Midwest Dairy Association / Orville Miller Farms



Orville and Mary Jane Miller are fourth generation dairy farmers in Reno County, Kansas. In the last twenty years they have grown their dairy from 40 to 190 cows. They have 180 head of calves and heifers in various stages of growth. The operation farms 900 acres, which is used to grow all the forage and grain for their cattle.

Miller Dairy is committed to producing top quality milk in a sustainable manner. It employs 6-8 people, including 3 family members. It also does custom farming and operates an ag equipment and auto repair shop.

Orville is an associate pastor at Plainview Mennonite Church and serves on a number of church and agriculture related boards. Mary Jane is involved in milking, feeding and management on the dairy. They have four children, with their youngest son, Brian employed by the farm.
